- To share accomplishments and obtain residents and their providers feedback in the BHC process, implementation, and evaluation.

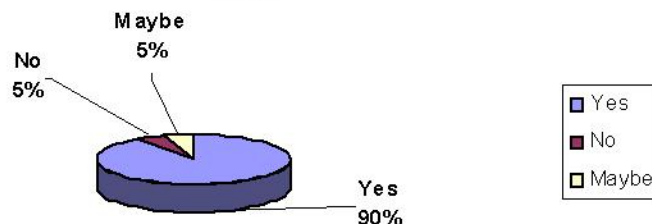
SMALL GROUP PRESENTATION

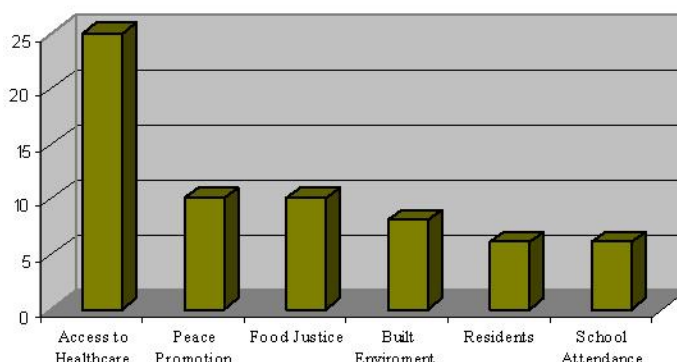
DISCUSSION

2. How residents could be involved in the next steps.

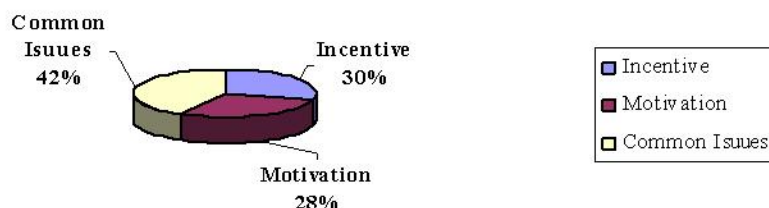
Would you be interested in participating in a Momentum Team?



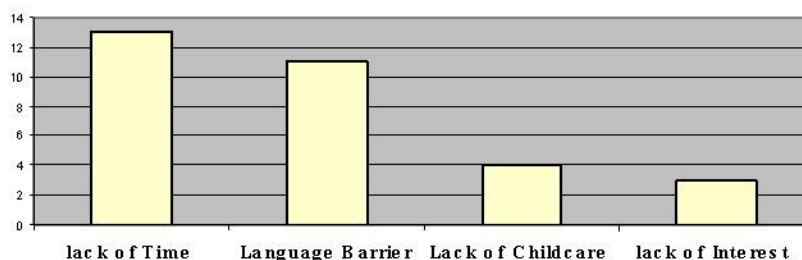
What Momentum Team are you interested in?
