Outcomes 4 & 8

- Previous survey data had a lot of bias and did not include community resident input
- Momentum teams influenced the process for the survey
- Two surveys were created to assess resident information
- Survey 2 looked at social demographics (volunteer work, etc.)
- Survey 1
- Correlations were made with the data (Sheila is putting together a presentation for the House Leaders)
- A lot residents had not ever been surveyed
- Sample questions asked were “Medical conditions, asthma rates, etc.”

Value to Built Environment (p.20)

- Lack of affordable housing
- No. 9 Home ownership by ethnicity
- Surveyed residents walk
- Goal is connect BE data with other momentum teams
- Crime prevention through design should be popular education course
- Job training is in high demand
- After school care
